**Settlement Scheme:** A message from our Vicar General which has just arrived: Many of us are unsure of the consequences that may arise from Brexit and the impact on citizens of the European Union, including many Clergy, living in the Diocese and throughout the United Kingdom. In March 2019 the Government is due to launch a Settlement Scheme. All EU citizens, other than Irish citizens, living in the UK will be required to make an application if they wish to remain here after the UK leaves the EU. Irish citizens living in the UK will not be required to apply as their rights are separately protected.
