The Palm Sunday Procession, which commemorates Jesus's entry into the city of Jerusalem, is celebrated outdoors by parishes across the diocese. The Sunday also marks the beginning of Holy Week, with the narrative of the Lord's Passion this year being taken from St Luke's Gospel.

At Westminster Cathedral Cardinal Vincent Nichols, Archbishop of Westminster, will preside over the Blessing of Palms, Procession and Mass. Holy Week continues with the Diocesan Chrism Mass, when the Holy Oils will be blessed for the coming year, taking place at Westminster Cathedral before the fuller liturgical celebration of the Triduum begins with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Maundy Thursday evening.

Among the many intentions and desires we will bring to our prayer and liturgies in April, This year it's the month that brings us Palm Sunday, Holy Week and Good Friday, then the bright triumph of absolute good over evil's darkness on Easter Day. In this month, Pope Francis invites us to pray for a particularly heroic and brave group: doctors and their humanitarian collaborators in war Zones, who risk their lives to save the lives of others—Médecins sans Frontières.
