The Memorare: As we are now in the month of May traditionally we focus more intensely on Our Blessed Lady. To that end, I thought it would be good to use the beautiful prayer of the Memorare during the Prayers of Intercession. It could hardly be more appropriate; the text is given below and will continue to appear in Snippets for the foreseeable future.

Remember, O most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thine intercession was left unaided.

Inspired by this confidence, I fly unto thee, O Virgin of virgins, my mother; to thee do I come, before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.

First Holy Communicants: I ask you to keep our First Holy Communicants in your prayers as they prepare to receive Our Blessed Lord for the first time on Sunday 19 May at 2.00pm. I thank their parents and our catechetical team for training them so well for this milestone in their spiritual lives.

Notre Dame collection: During the course of this week I hope to bring the collection of over £500.00 to the Archpriest of Notre Dame de Paris as a sign of solidarity and so that he can use our donation in whatever way he sees fit.

Priest Training Fund Collection: Today is Good Shepherd Sunday, the day we pray for priests and vocations to the priesthood. The annual collection for the Priest Training will take place next weekend. This fund pays for the priestly formation of men for the Catholic priesthood. There are currently 45 men studying at Allen Hall seminary, 27 of whom are for our own Diocese, and last year eight men ordained to the priesthood to serve as our priests.
