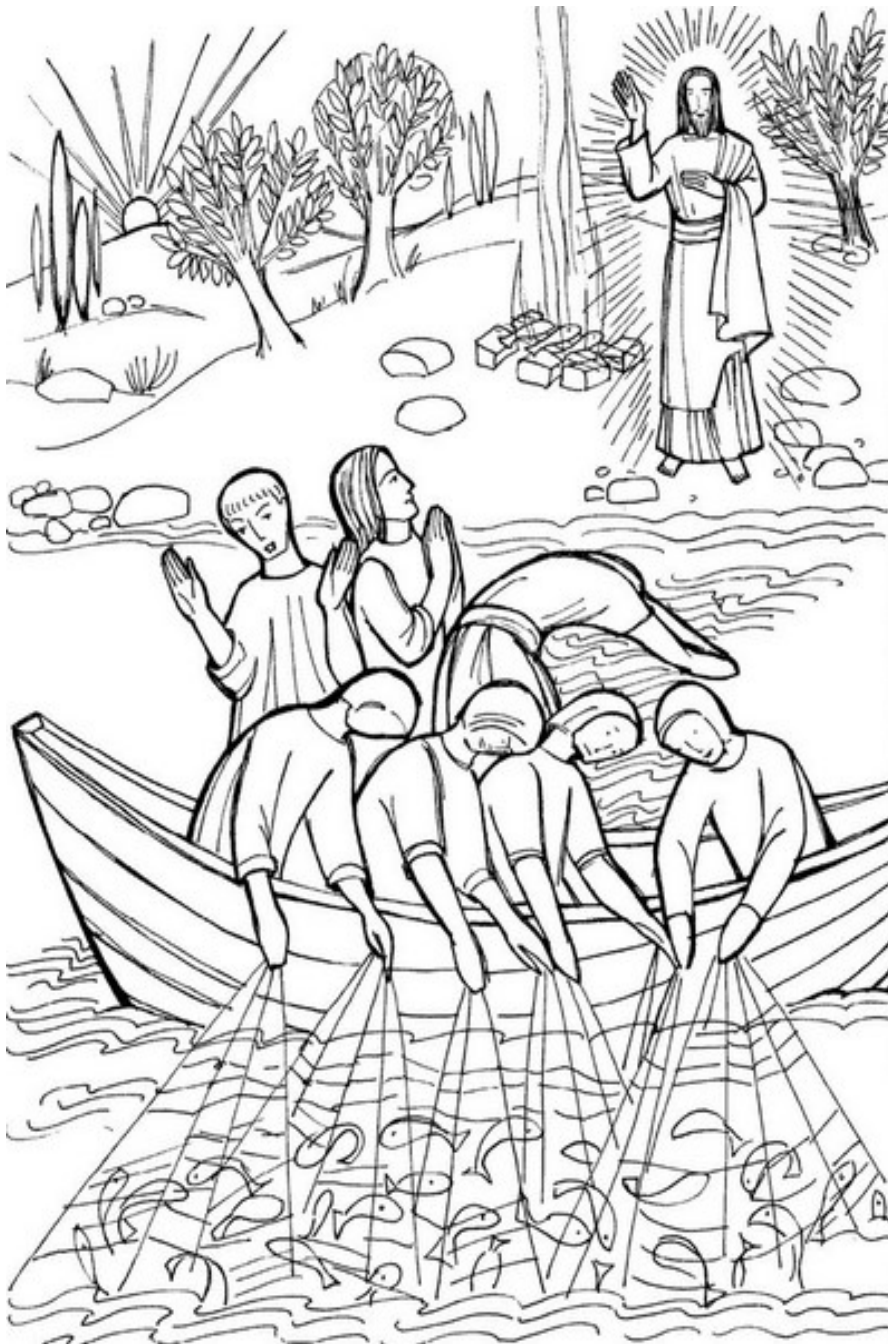

Canonisation of Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman: as you may be aware already Pope Francis has authorised the Canonisation ceremony to take place at St Peter's in Rome on Sunday 13 October when he will be made a Saint of our Church. Having had the privilege of attending his Beatification in Birmingham by Pope Benedict it is my intention to be present for his Canonisation. Perhaps in October 2020 we can plan to take a parish pilgrimage to Rome and Castel Gondolfo, the previous summer residence of the Popes, which can be visited throughout. Nick O'Donnell and I have done 'recce' and we acquired a great deal of useful information.

The church flooring. Following the painting of the church which has been universally admired by everyone we have decided to take a short breather before proceeding to the flooring of the church which is likely to happen in September. Professional advisers have told us that contractors tend to be fully booked up with school work during the summer months and that we are likely to get a rather better deal if we wait until September. Again on the advice of the professionals we are minded to use carpet tiles, which means that the old flooring will not need to be lifted, and this solution will be economically and aesthetically the best option.

The AGM of the parish will be held in the Lady Chapel shortly after the 10.00am Mass as the hall has been booked by Agnes Odiachi. Of course all parishioners are cordially invited to attend.
