Blessed John Henry Cardinal Newman: How wonderful it was to read the headline in The Times: 'Britain to get first saint of modern times'. Almost certainly you will have heard that Pope Francis has given his final approval for the Canonisation of this great figure in the ecclesiastical history of our nation. The Holy Father has accepted that a second miracle has occurred thanks to prayerful recourse to Blessed John Henry. This will cause great rejoicing in our English church and beyond, to say nothing of the joy it will bring to our esteemed local Catholic secondary school dedicated to him. Our own Cardinal Vincent Nichols has tweeted: 'For me the truly remarkable nature of this moment is that this is an English parish priest being declared a saint. I hope every parish priest in England will hold his head high today. Newman's exploration of faith, depth of personal courage, intellectual clarity and cultural sensitivity make him a deeply admired follower of Christ.'
